THE PROJECT SUPPORTS BUILDING A 3,780 MW HYDROPOWER PLANT IN TAJIKISTAN, FEATURING A 335-METER-HIGH DAM AND A 170 KM² RESERVOIR

1959

First proposed

BY 1965

Technical scheme was developed

1976

Beginning of Construction

1993

Buildingsite was abandoned after the collapse of the Soviet Union

2008

Tajikistan announced that construction of the dam had been resumed

2009

Tajikistan authorities relocated the first 232 families from three villages

2012

the construction site of the dam was paused awaiting assessment by the World Bank reports

2014

Techno-Economic Assessment Study (TEAS) and the Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA) documents released: The expert panel agreed to construct the dam at the proposed site, with adjustments to the original design and the implementation of a monitoring system for the dam's duration.

2016

The Italian company Salini Impregilo was chosen to carry out the construction. Okt. 29th official relaunch of the construction
